



Students' Code of Conduct

All students enrolled in the Maplewood international School are expected to adhere to the *Students' Code of Conduct*. This code is consistent with the expectations for students as defined by the Alberta Guide to Education and by the ADEC guidelines and policies that regulate private school behavioral expectations for students.

The code of conduct requires that all students:

1. Be diligent in pursuing their studies.
2. Attend school regularly and punctually.
3. Cooperate fully with everyone authorized by the school to provide educational programs and other services.
4. Comply with the rules of the school.
5. Account to their teachers, the school social worker, their parents, and the administration for their conduct while in school.
6. Respect the rights of others.
7. Ensure that their conduct contributes to a welcoming, caring, respectful, and safe learning environment that respects diversity and fosters a sense of belonging for other students and staff.
8. Refrain from bullying or bullying behaviors directed towards others in the school, whether or not it occurs within the school's building, during the school day, or by electronic means.
9. Report bullying that they see or of which they are aware.
10. Positively contribute to the school and the school's community by participating with good intentions and proper behavior.

As per ADEC policy, parents are responsible for reviewing the Maplewood School's *Student Code of Conduct* with their son or daughter. The parents are expected to explain these expectations to their son or daughter and who will then, in turn, obey and demonstrate respect towards all classmates and faculty.

As problems arise, if any, parents will work cooperatively with the school, and support the MWIS staff in ensuring that their son or daughter complies with the school's behavioral, attendance, and academic work expectations.
